A-1 Macomb County Veteran's Center - The Vet Center Program was established by Congress in 1979 out of the recognition that a significant number of Vietnam era veterans were still experiencing readjustment problems. Vet Centers are community based and part of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. The goal of the Vet center program is to provide a broad range of counseling, outreach, and referral services to eligible veterans and their families.

A-2 Health Department - The Health Department provides a wide range of programs and services through three major divisions: Environmental Health Services, Family Health Services, and Health Promotion/Disease Control. The Health Department oversees the Medical Examiner's Office and the Animal Shelter, provides health-related data and statistics, and maintains Emergency Preparedness capabilities.

B-4 Arab Community For Economic and Social Services (ACCESS) - ACCESS Sterling Heights provides medical, behavioral, and public health services to working families, immigrants, and refugees along with programs focused on employment-based ESL education, financial coaching, and entrepreneurship. **(This tour qualifies for 1.5 MCBAP Substance Abuse Hours)**

C-1 Veteran's Court - Our mission is to serve Macomb County veterans in the justice system through a specialized treatment court docket, focusing on substance abuse and mental health treatment, and by providing the tools required to lead productive and law-abiding lives. Participating Courts: 16th Circuit Court, 41B District Court, 41A District Court. **(This tour qualifies for 2 MCBAP Substance Abuse Hours)**

C-2 Macomb County Jail - The Macomb County Jail currently has a 1,238 rated design capacity. It houses pre-trial detainees and prisoners sentenced to one year or less. The facility is staffed by Corrections Officers, Deputy Sheriffs, Sheriff Command Officers, and a variety of support staff and volunteers. Many programs at the Macomb County Jail help to assist in providing services and the life skills necessary to help reduce recidivism. **(This tour qualifies for 2 MCBAP Substance Abuse Hours)**

C-3 Turning Point - Turning Point offers comprehensive services to survivors of Domestic Violence and Sexual Violence and their families. Besides the Shelter Program, Turning Point has Counseling Program, Community Development, Prevention-Education, Community Advocacy Program, and a Second Hand Store all housed at one site. C-4 Family Youth Interventions (FYI) - Family Youth Interventions (FYI) is dedicated to helping youth in runaway, homeless and crisis situations. FYI has an array of services for youth and their families including: Emergency Shelter/Basic Center for ages 12 thru 17; Homeless Youth/Transitional Program for young people 16 thru 20; Transitional Living Program for young people 16 thru 20; Street Outreach Program and Youth Drop-in Center (The Refuge).

E-1 Alcohol Highway Safety - Christopher Lineberger, Director, will begin by introducing TSA/AHSP and give a brief presentation on his agency's positive influence in the community, as well as explain and discuss the educational programs TSA/AHSP offers. Residents of MATTS are offered case management, counseling service, hot meals, clothing, and medical care.

F-1 Macomb County Sheriff's Department, Marine Division - The Marine Division enforces and investigates all violations of marine and criminal state laws that occur on the lake. The Sheriff Marine Division is the only government agency in Macomb County that is capable of fighting fires on the water. The Sheriff's Marine Division is mandated by state and federal legislation to provide a search and recovery team to recover drowning victims from any body of water in Macomb County.
