A-1 Gianna House

Site: Gianna House

In January 2018, Gianna House opened its residential program for pregnant teens. The teens may come anytime during pregnancy and stay up to one year after birthing, during which time they continue their high school education, and gain parenting and life skills. Gianna House has operated as a pregnancy and parenting center for expectant and new mothers of any age since 2015. Come see the new additions!

A-2 Crossroads Clubhouse

Site: Crossroads Clubhouse

Crossroads Clubhouse is a psychosocial rehabilitation program for adults diagnosed with severe and persistent mental illness. Based on the Fountain House Clubhouse model, and adhering to the International Standards for Clubhouse Programs, it provides both formal and informal structure through which Clubhouse Members control their own participation and involvement in the community.

A-3 Juvenile Justice Center (JJC)

Site: Juvenile Justice Center

The Macomb County Juvenile Justice Center is operated under the auspice of the County Executive and offers both short-term detention and long-term residential treatment services for at-risk youth ages 11 to 17. Receive an overview of the purpose of the JJC as well as an explanation of the services and interventions offered. ***This tour is eligible for 1.5 MCBAP Substance Abuse Contact Hours.***

A-4 Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 154

Site: Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 154 Veterans Support Center

Tour the on-site Vietnam Veteran Museum and Food Pantry! Learn how the Support Center helps the veteran community with no-cost support services such as the Veteran's Food Pantry, Honor Guard Burial, POW/MIA Initiative, Support Center, Outreach location for VA Service Officers and Operation Christmas.
