2019 Emergency Medication Administration FOR CLS AND RESPITE STAFF



This training is for CLS and Respite Staff of MCCMH contracted provider system who serve an individual who is prescribed one of these emergency medications; Diazepam, Glucose Tabs and Epinephrine pens. This class is intended to provide general emergency protocol guidelines regarding diabetes, severe allergic reactions/anaphylaxis, and seizures to non-medical personnel (CLS staff). These include discussions about:

- **Epinephrine auto-injector**, a life-saving drug used to treat anaphylaxis
- **Glucose tablets** for treatment of severe hypoglycemia
- **Diazepam rectal gel**, commonly used in seizure emergency treatment plans
