Seeking Safety Course Description:

The goal of this course is to learn *Seeking Safety*, an evidence-based treatment for trauma and/or substance abuse. Background on trauma and substance abuse will be covered as well as implementation of *Seeking Safety* (overview, evidence base, fidelity). By the end of the training, therapists will be able to implement *Seeking Safety* in their setting and facilitators will be able to apply the key principles to their work the individuals they serve.
