

2020 MEDICATION UPDATE TRAINING



Who must complete a Medication Update class?

- All Direct Support Professionals in a residential setting (group home, SIP) who have successfully completed a DSP (formerly DCW)training curriculum from an approved MCCMH Service Provider.

When must it be completed?

- 2 years from completion of Direct Support Professional Training (no matter what agency facilitated the training).
- Biannually; every two years to maintain certification to pass medications.

Workforce Development/Training Dept Policy

- Failing the Medication Update class requires that the entire Medications module of the DSP training must be retaken.
- Failing the Medication Update disqualifies a person from administering medications until the Medication module of DSP training is completed.
- Staff who fail Medication Update cannot be counted in the consumer-to-staff ratio until the Medication module of DSP training is completed.
- Trainees will not have the option of testing-out of this training.

These are tentative training dates and the training department may change or cancel the listed dates as a result of low registration.

PLEASE NOTE: Due to parking lot accessibility, trainees may park in the back lot, but must enter the lot off of Beattie Street. Trainees need to walk around the building to the East entrance.
